RULES & REGULATIONS

-  The competitions are open to single women (never married) between the ages of 5 and 21, and boys between the ages of 5 and 8, as of July 16th, 2016.
-  Contestants must be residents of either the City of Tonawanda or North Tonawanda and provide proof of residency along with the completed application form. (Proof of residency: photocopy of School Report Card, School ID, Drivers License or Parent ID for pre-schoolers only.)
-  All QUEEN and TEEN contestants must attend FOUR mandatory events prior to the pageant.
 1. The Pageant Orientation. Takes place on **Sunday, July 10th** from 6:00 - 8:00 pm. Located at Project 308 Gallery. Dress for this event is casual but contestants should be prepared to have their photo taken.
 2. The Private Interviews : **Wednesday July 13th** at the YWCA from 5-6PM.
 3. A Stage Rehearsal **Friday, July 15th** at the Riviera Theatre from 6:00 - 9:00 pm.
 4. A Final Rehearsal will take place at **4:00 pm on Saturday** before the pageant. Queen and Teen contestants will model a casual outfit and a formal dress or gown in the stage competition.
-  PRINCESS AND MISTER contestants will take part in a mandatory Rehearsal Workshop (NO EXCEPTIONS) on Friday, July 15th - 4:00 - 6:00 pm at the Riviera Theatre on Webster St. During the workshop, contestants will rehearse and have an opportunity to ask questions about the competition. (No need to dress up, but contestants might want to wear the shoes they intend to have on during the pageant.)
-  Princess contestants are encouraged to wear a party dress for the competition. Little Mister contestants should wear a shirt and tie. Each contestant will walk on stage and take part in a brief "interview" with the pageant emcee.
-  Judging is based on confidence, personality and appearance/poise. Canal Fest Queen and Teen contestants will also be scored on their ability to express their opinions and ideas.
-  Each entrant will be asked to make a \$15 dollar donation to help defray pageant expenses, however no contestant will be denied participation because of inability to pay.
-  Titleholders will win a crown, banner, & trophy. The Queen will receive a scholarship as well. Winners will also take part in the Canal Fest Parade on Tuesday, July 19th at 6:00 pm. Runners-up in each division will receive a trophy. All contestants will receive an award for participating.
-  A \$2 admission fee per person at the door on competition day will be donated back to the Canal Fest (a not-for-profit organization) Pageants to help defray expenses. Admission fee is good for all day. Children under 10 will be admitted for free.
